### Locations

Suggested areas include, but are not limited to, Dolphin Head Recreation, Spring Lake, Whooping Crane Conservancy, the ball fields, and other common property.

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# Veterans Memorial Brick Program

Another popular remembrance is the Veterans Memorial Brick Program. Located at the Plantation House under the flagpole, residents may purchase a brick that can be inscribed to honor a loved one.

### Criteria:

- Donor must be a Hilton Head Plantation Property Owner or Resident.
- The brick must be in memory or honor of a family member.
- The family member must be in the armed forces or a veteran.
- Inscription can be up to 3 lines, 18 characters per line, including spaces.
- \$75 per brick.
